### ***When is it?***

The campaign takes place starting on August 16th until August 22nd, 2006. Shifts will only be when students are moving in the dorms. The MANDATORY sign up sessions and orientation are on 8/15/06 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. and 9/15/06 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.

### ***What is it?***

This is an organized effort to capture the tons and tons of cardboard that are usually discarded when students move into the residence halls across campus. You can help us out (and have fun) by becoming a monitor at the sites, usually located near the dumpster, by informing people to recycle cardboard (instead of tossing it into the dumpster) and helping them break down boxes as we transport them to the Recycling Center.

### ***Why do it?***

It's obvious! You get to make an huge positive impact on the environment - last year we collected approximately 8.5 tons of cardboard last year! Not only did that cardboard get recycled, but it also went to the waste stream that Texas State pays big bucks for. Not to mention you can meet awesome people, beautify our campus and hang out outside! (and get paid!)

### ***What do I get?***

You will be paid an awesome \$8.00 an hour, provided a snacks/water per a shift and a super famous Texas State Recycles T-shirt for your services. Shifts are between 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. and 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. between August 16th, 2006 until August 22nd, 2006. You also get the benefit of helping Texas State save money and the environment!

### ***Where do I sign up?***

First of all, you MUST BE A REGISTERED STUDENT to be hired. The MANDATORY orientation sessions and orientation are on 8/14/06 1-3 p.m. and 9/15/06 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. at the Recycling Warehouse on Moore Street (Click here for a [google map](#), or click here for a [Texas State map](#).) There you will complete necessary paperwork, get instructions to be an efficient monitor and we will let you know what to do next. You MUST attend this if you are to be hired.
