Course requirements:

a) There will be two in-class short-answer essay examinations worth 30% each.

b) A weekly notebook will contribute to 30% of the final grade. You must have at least eight entries in your notebooks by the close of the semester. Each of the first seven entries should be one to two pages in length, and the final entry should be three. NO CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN AT THE END OF THE

SEMESTER TO A NOTEBOOK THAT LACKS THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES.

Instead of a notebook, students may choose to construct a 'zine, website, blog, podcast or Powerpoint over the course of the semester. Please see me for details and examples.

c) Class attendance and participation will comprise 10% of the final grade. All students are encouraged to contribute in an informed and thoughtful fashion to both the discussion in class and to the on-line discussion group for the course. Students may also, with the consultation of the instructor, give short (10-minute) presentations to the class on topics relevant to our course work.
