Generally, the application process is completed in the Winter/Spring for enrollment the following Fall semester. We normally process between 60 and 120 applications for the 15 positions available. Students are generally notified before mid-May as to their standing.

Spring admission is contingent upon an appropriate academic background and a current student dropping out of the program. Application materials should be received by November 1 for Spring applicants. Often, we do not know whether space is available in a Spring class until late registration begins in mid January. We normally process between 5 and 10 applications for Spring admission. Spring admission is rather rare.

Applicants must be prepared to study music at a university level. Generally, this means they have studied an appropriate instrument (or voice part) formally for several years. *Note: Some instruments and/or playing styles are not available for study at Texas State University.*
