

SLAC's Steps to Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Preparation

1. Pick up the current GRE *Information & Registration Bulletin* from the SLAC rack in room 411, or ask for one at the SLAC Lab front desk. This bulletin contains the necessary forms for registering for the GRE, as well as information about the test and preparation tips.
2. Visit GRE.org, the web site on which you can register for the GRE, download practice reviews and tests, and check for updates about the test.
3. Take the practice GRE to assess what areas you need to improve in.
4. Since the GRE Verbal section focuses on vocabulary, begin working on this area as soon as possible. SLAC has vocabulary study aids available online.
5. Use SLAC's other online exercises under the GRE or Content Area Help.
6. Seek tutoring in the SLAC lab in areas you need to work on.
7. Sign up for workshops with Princeton or Kaplan if necessary.
