National Student Exchange (NSE)

Want to study outside the state of Texas for **in-state** tuition and fees? Interested in attending an institution located in some of the hottest (or coolest) vacation spots in America? You can do so by exploring the **Texas State National Student Exchange Program**. NSE is a program that provides a unique opportunity for Texas State students to study at one of over 180 colleges and universities across the nation. You can temporarily reside in one of 49 states or US territories, including Hawaii, Puerto Rico, Guam, and the Virgin Islands.

To qualify, you must be a full-time student and have completed at least 30 credit hours. A 2.5 GPA or better is required upon submission of the application and at a completion of the semester prior to the exchange. - Once there, click the link at the bottom of the page, taking you to the log-in screen
- As a new member, enter the access code into the Access Code field. Select a Desired ID (under 10 characters). Click on start
